MEAL DISTRIBUTION

The food bank was able to serve over 137 million families since March of 2020 with more than a 145% increase in distribution. During a normal month prepandemic, it would serve about 300,00 individuals. It now averages 900,00 individuals per month.





HELP IN TOUGH TIMES

The LA county unemployment reached a high of over 20% in May of last year. Seeing the community needed help, the food bank increased production by 70% the next month thanks to the staff, partners, and volunteers commitment.

NEW PARTNERS

The food bank is able to assist people with the help of about 600 partner agencies throughout LA. In the last year, it's increased that number to 700. Combined with other food bank agencies, it distributed \$275 million worth of food last year.

As distribution numbers continued to surge, the food bank consistently recruited new volunteers to help. The National Guard was deployed to help assemble food distribution boxes. Aside from meals, the food bank was able to give out more than 3 million diapers last year as well.
